

Dear Valued Patient:

Thank you for choosing Blaine Orthopedic Surgery Center for your medical needs. The below billing and financial information is to offer you information that should help you to understand how we will bill your procedure or services today.

- Bring a copy of your insurance card with you on the day of the surgery to ensure timely and accurate submission of your claim to your insurance company.
 - If your surgery is related to a workers comp injury please bring the work comp carrier name, claim number, the date of your injury, and the adjuster's name and phone number.
 - If your surgery is related to an automobile or liability accident, we will need the information of your carrier, policy or claim number, date of accident, and adjusters contact information. We will bill your automobile or liability insurance as a courtesy however the cost of this service will be your responsibility if the insurance does not pay for the facility charges in a timely manner.
- It is your responsibility as the patient to understand your insurance coverage. We will bill your
 insurance company or work comp carrier but any patient responsibility or non-covered charges may be
 billed directly to you and are expected to be paid in full upon receipt of the statement.
 - Many insurances now limit the in-network surgical facilities available to patients. It is important to understand that your surgeon may be considered in-network and the surgical facility could be out-of-network. This COULD DRAMATICALLY CHANGE the amount that you may be required to pay. All patients are encouraged to contact their insurance to confirm that Blaine ASC is considered in-network with their insurance plan to minimize patient financial liability.
- If you do not have insurance and will be paying for your procedure privately we ask for payment in full prior to the day of surgery. We do offer a self-pay discount for payment in full, however, if you are unable to pay in full you can contact the billing department to make an arrangement that include a down payment and short payment arrangement.
- Please be aware that you will be receiving a bill from the Surgery Center, the Surgeon's office, and the Anesthesia professional group. This means you will have a possibility of receiving approximately three bills from your procedure and/or services today.

• Anesthesia Services

This professional charge is for the assessment, supervision, and administration of anesthesia by a Medical Doctor of Anesthesia and Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist during and after your procedure.

<u>Professional Services</u>

Twin Cities Orthopedics

This professional charge is for the surgeon or provider that performed your procedure. This professional group practices at our facility.
